FINNEY COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS CONFIRM FOURTH DEATH RELATED TO COVID-19

Finney County, Kansas – The Finney County Health Department confirmed its fourth death of a Finney County resident related to coronavirus (COVID-19) today. The patient was in his 80s and had underlying medical conditions. Our staff extends our sympathies to his family as they navigate this loss.

To continue to care for our community and protect the most vulnerable, our health recommendation is to continue to limit the time you spend in public spaces and stay home. Residents should only leave their homes for essential reasons, and when they leave should practice social distancing and wear a cloth face mask.
