FINNEY COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS ANNOUNCE FIFTH COVID-19 RELATED DEATH

Finney County, Kansas – Today, health officials have identified the fifth COVID-19 related death of a Finney County resident. The patient was in his 80s and had underlying health conditions. Our sympathies go out to the family in this difficult time.

In an effort to protect the most vulnerable in our community, and to continue to protect yourself, we urge you to continue to take preventative actions. Limit your time in public spaces. When you are out in public, wear a cloth facemask and social distance by staying six (6) feet from other people. Upon returning home from a public space, change your clothing immediately and wash your hands for 20 seconds with soap and water. Frequently sanitize items such as keys or cell phones. Monitor your health and if you begin to experience a fever, cough, loss of taste or smell, or shortness of breath, please call the local COVID-19 hotline at (620) 272-3600 Monday-Saturday, 8:00 AM-5:00 PM.
