FINNEY COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS ANNOUNCE SIXTH COVID-19 RELATED DEATH

Finney County, Kansas – Finney County Health Officials have announced the sixth COVID-19 related death of a Finney County resident. The individual was in his 60s and had underlying health conditions. No other information about the individual will be released.

At the time of this release, Finney County has 1,234 total positive cases, 1,276 total negative cases, and six (6) COVID-19 related deaths. Finney County Health Department updates their website, <https://www.finneycounty.org/755/Coronavirus-COVID-19>, at the end of each day with new total counts as new results are received and totaled.

We continue to recommend people take preventative actions. Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds regularly, wear a cloth facemask in public areas, and practice social distancing by staying six (6) feet away from other people. Continue to limit your time in public spaces and stay home as much as possible.
