

Non-Congregate Housing

In southwest Kansas, there is a significant amount of multi-generational and multi-family housing, and if someone is exposed to COVID-19, they might not be able to safely quarantine or self-isolate at home.

Kansas Division of Emergency Management, in collaboration with Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Kansas Department of Children and Families, and the local public health department has set up non-congregate housing in Finney County. These facilities are available to use for individuals who may have been exposed to COVID-19 or to isolate individuals with laboratory-confirmed positive cases. The facilities will provide for needs, including, meals, laundry services, cleaning, and a shelter manager to assist individuals should other needs arise.
