FINNEY COUNTY HEALTH OFFICIALS CONFIRM SEVENTH AND EIGHTH COVID-19 RELATED DEATH

Finney County, Kansas – Local health officials have identified the seventh and eighth COVID-19 related deaths of Finney County residents. One individual was in his 70s and had no underlying medical conditions. The other individual was in his 60s and had underlying medical conditions. Our hearts go out to both families in this time as they process this loss.

Continue to make every effort to protect yourself and the most vulnerable in our community. Limit your time in public places. Practice social distancing by staying six (6) feet away from other people and wear a cloth facemask when social distancing is difficult. Regularly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 second. Disinfect frequently used objects such as your phone or keys upon return to your home.
