COUNTY COMMISSION VOTES TO REOPEN ON JUNE 8

(FINNEY COUNTY,KS) – The Finney County Board of Commission sitting as the Local Board of Health voted 5-0 Friday morning in special session to reopen Finney County without restrictions in regards to closures or gatherings on June 8, 2020. Each business and organization will be responsible for determining best practices and procedures for the health and safety of their employees and patrons. The vote also authorized the county to remain in Phase 1.5 of Governor Kelly’s Ad Astra Plan until June 8, 2020. County buildings will remain closed to the public until June 8 to give county officials time to finalize procedures for social distancing practices to protect residents and employees. At the time of reopening, we will publish finalized plans and procedures.
