## **COVID-19 VACCINATIONS TO RELOCATE TO FINNEY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT**

Finney County, Kansas – Beginning Monday, April 26, 2021, the Mass Vaccination Clinic, previously located at Finney County Fairgrounds, will provide vaccines at Finney County Health Department, 919 Zerr Rd., Garden City, KS 67846.

Individuals receiving the vaccine will park on the east side of the building and a staff member will come outside to administer the vaccine. For all COVID-19 vaccines given at Finney County Health Department, patients will remain in the vehicle for the duration of the vaccination and 15-minute observation period.

Times for vaccine appointments and walk-ins (drive up) are available and will be posted each Friday for the following week. Walk-in hours have been reduced as the demand for vaccines has decreased. This will allow us to check our daily numbers sooner and ensure no vaccines are left over at the end of each day.
