

NOTICE OF SPECIAL QUESTION ELECTION
TO ALL OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF GARDEN CITY, KANSAS:

Notice is given by the Governing Body of the City of Garden City, Kansas and the County Election Officer of Finney County, Kansas that a special question election will be held in the City of Garden City on August 6, 2024, for the purpose of voting on the question of levying a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (0.50%) on retail sales consummated within the City of Garden City, Kansas, according to the provisions of K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.* If approved, the retailers' sales tax will begin upon expiration of the City's existing one-half of one percent retailers' sales tax on October 1, 2025 or as soon thereafter as the tax may be levied by the Kansas Department of Revenue and the revenue received by the City will be used for public purposes as described in the ballot question. If approved by a majority of the electors voting such tax shall be collected by the Kansas Department of Revenue, and the revenue returned to the city of Garden City.

Shall the City of Garden City, Kansas be authorized to levy a retailers' sales tax in the amount of one-half of one percent (0.50%), to take effect upon expiration of the City's existing one-half of one percent retailers' sales tax on October 1, 2025, or as soon thereafter as the tax may be levied by the Kansas Department of Revenue; provided such tax will expire 10 years after it is first levied, with revenues of such tax used to stabilize the City's ad valorem property tax levy and finance construction and maintenance of transportation improvements, all pursuant to K.S.A. 12-187 *et seq.*, as amended?
