

NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES OF REGISTRATION

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters will be open at the following places during regular business hours:

Persons who apply for services at voter registration agencies may register at the following places during regular business hours:

Kansas Dept. for Children & Families

Dept of Health and Environment (WIC)

Russell Child Development

Southwest Developmental Services

Finney County Senior Center

Compass Behavioral Health

At 11:59 p.m. on the 15th day of October 2024, the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 6th day of November 2024.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceeding or changes residence. The voter may re-register in person, by mail or other delivery when registration is open or the voter may re-register on Election Day. Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer or the Secretary of State upon request. The application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
